Dear Parents

I know it is not long since my last newsletter, but there are some important issues which I need to inform you of.



## DENOMINATIONAL INSPECTION

This is just a reminder that our Denominational Inspection will take place on Tuesday 19 June, which will look at our worship, links with the church and the teaching of Religious Education.

## PE KITS

Children who do not have their PE kits in school each week are causing a considerable amount of problems. Over the last few weeks, we have been holding heats and practicing the races for sports day. We have also had a variety of coaches from the Sports Partnership, including tennis and aerobics. It is a pity for children to miss out on these opportunities, for example, this week there were five children from Year 5 who did not have their PE kits in school.



We cannot re-run heats for races to accommodate children who do not have their kit with them on the day. This would be unfair to those who do have their kits and have won the heats as well as causing a considerable amount of re-timetabling for the teachers.

Please make sure that full PE kits are in school from Monday to Friday every week. Please also ensure that plimsolls fit and have not become too small.

## MISS LESTER

In September, Miss Lester will be stepping down from her Deputy Headteacher and class teacher role. She will be working three days per week as the Music Manager for the school, will co-ordinate music across the whole school and teach music in KS2. Miss Lester will continue to run the wonderful choir as well as training choir and recorders and will liaise with the peripatetic teachers. A proportion of Miss Lester's time will also be spent in Year 6 alongside Mrs Olive-Jones. As part of her new role, Miss Lester will be teaching some French to Key Stage 2, with Mrs Olive-Jones and Miss Gick. I would like to take this opportunity to publicly thank Miss Lester for her sterling work as my deputy and an outstanding class teacher.
