Why Do Christians Believe the Words of Jesus Are So Important?

The significance of Jesus' words is highlighted in passages such as Matthew 24:35, where He asserts, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away." This declaration affirms the enduring nature of His teachings, which remain relevant and commanding across all generations.
