Peace is a time when there are **no fights or wars**. It means being calm and quiet, like a still pond without ripples. It can also mean a state of **freedom from conflict** and a feeling of harmony and safety. Many people and groups work hard to achieve peace in the world. In the Bible, **peace** is defined as a state of tranquility and harmony that comes from God. For children, it can be explained as **the feeling of calmness and safety** that God gives us, especially when we trust in Him. The Bible teaches that true peace is a fruit of the Holy Spirit and is made possible through Jesus Christ.
