JUSTICE

Christians view **justice as a divine mandate** that reflects God's righteousness and holiness. It is not just a legal or social concept; it is a fundamental principle guiding the lives of believers.

- **Biblical Justice:** It emphasizes fairness, love, and mercy, as seen in the commandments to act justly and love one's neighbor (Micah 6:8).
- **Community Responsibility:** Christians are called to care for the vulnerable and defend the oppressed, reflecting God's love and justice.
- **Restoration of Justice:** The concept of biblical justice contrasts with punitive justice, which focuses on temporary consequences rather than healing and restoration.

In summary, justice in Christianity is about living out God's character and values, promoting fairness and compassion in all aspects of life.
