Amen.

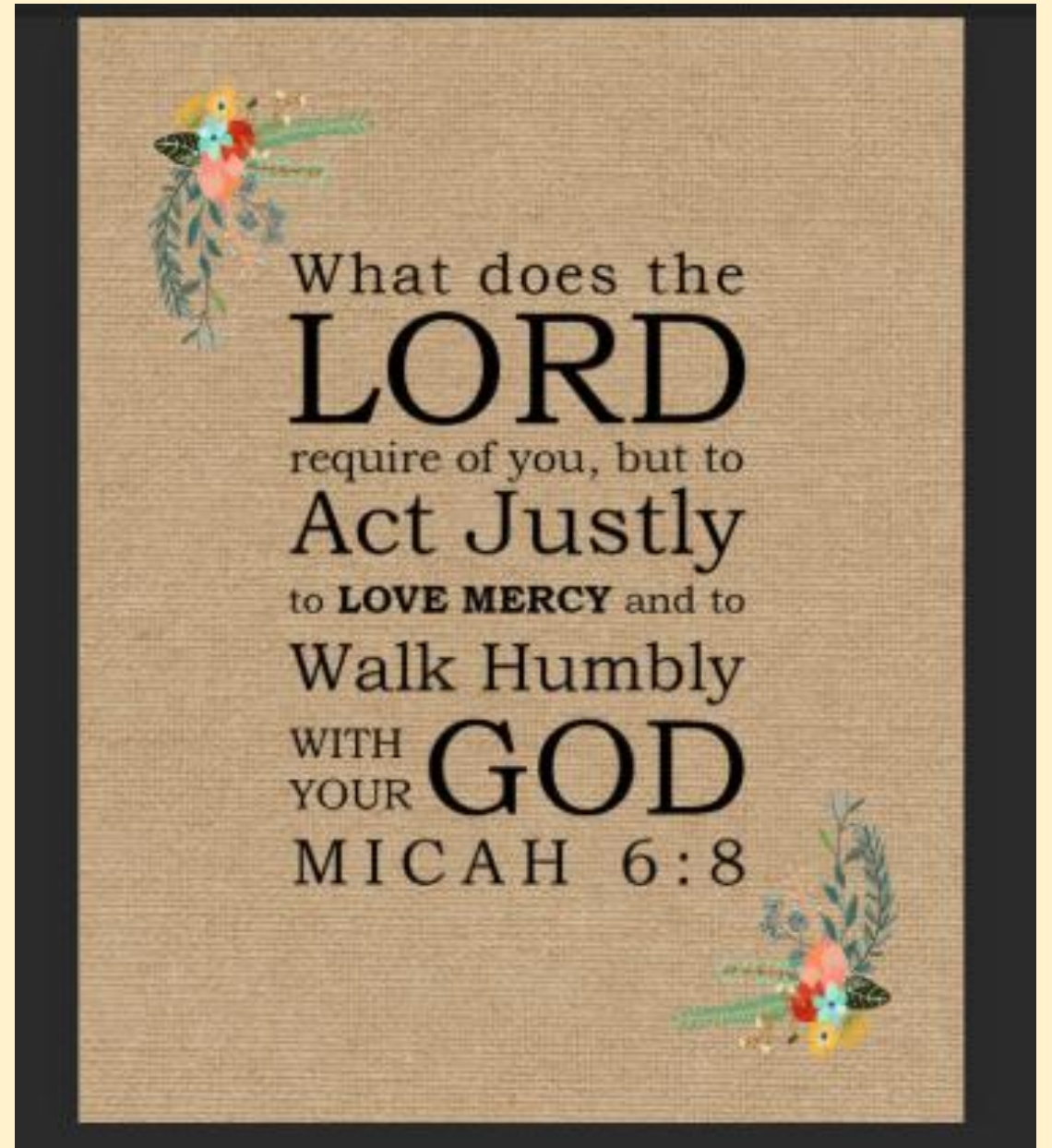




Justice

Equality

Equity



Everyone gets the supports they need (this is the concept of "affirmative action"), thus producing equity.
