## The MIRACLES of JESUS

### Lessons of Faith and Compassion

The miracles of Jesus are not only remarkable events but also profound teachings that reveal deeper spiritual and theological truths.

Each miracle highlights different aspects of Jesus' divine nature, His compassion, and His mission. For instance, the miracle of turning water into wine at the wedding

in Cana symbolizes the inauguration of the new covenant, while the miracle of feeding the five thousand illustrates God's provision and the call to share what we have with others. These miracles also teach us the importance of faith, as seen in Jesus' walking on water, and the need for compassion, as demonstrated in His healing of the sick.
