Wisdom in the Bible is about knowing what is right and making good choices, and it is important for everyone.

What is Wisdom?

Wisdom, as described in the Bible, is not just about having knowledge; it is about applying that knowledge to make good decisions. For children, this means understanding the rules at home or school and choosing to follow them. Wisdom helps children live happy and safe lives by guiding them to make choices that align with God's teachings.
