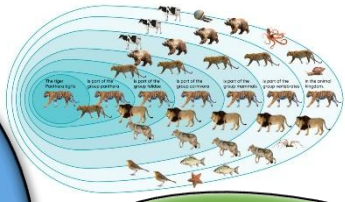




Safeguarding

This half term, we will learn how to recognise and report online bullying, and why it's important to save evidence. We will explore how to create strong passwords, manage them safely, and what to do if accounts are hacked. We will also learn to spot scams, phishing emails, and malware, and how to keep our devices safe by updating software.

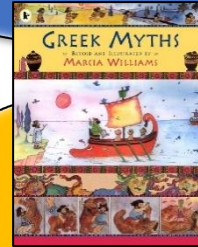


Science

As scientists, we will identify and group organisms, use classification keys, record findings with diagrams, explore how microorganisms are alive, and learn why Linnaeus's work matters.

English

Using the text Greek Myths by Marcia Williams, we will explore a number of Greek Myths including Theseus and the Minotaur, King Midas and Heracles. We will create our own monsters and write a new section of a Greek Myth.



Maths

As mathematicians we will consolidate our learning from the last two terms. We will undertake projects to enable us to be ready for secondary school. Concepts will include personal budgeting, wages, bills, decorating and cooking.



Computing

As computing technicians we will learn how to use spreadsheets by organising data into rows and columns. We'll explore formatting and formulas to calculate data, including applying formulas to multiple cells. We'll use spreadsheets to plan an event, create charts, and evaluate our results.



What have the Ancient Greeks ever done for us?

French

As multilingualists, we will learn how to say the date and our birthday in French, talk and write about pets, using both first and third person, and use conjunctions to join ideas. We will describe where we live and the rooms in our home.

Art

As artists, we will learn about and create repeating patterns inspired by the Ancient Greeks. Then, we'll design our own tile in their style and make the tile using ceramic joining techniques.

As historians, we will explore when Ancient Greece happened and ask questions about the time period. We'll learn how Ancient Greek democracy worked and why it's important today. We'll also find out about Greek gods and goddesses, the origins of the Olympics, and the events in the Ancient Greek games.

PHSE

This half term, we will learn to understand the value and impact of money, how to keep it safe, the risks associated with it (including gambling), and explore different careers, their roles, responsibilities, and pathways. We will explore puberty and relationships, media awareness, early human development, and basic first aid.



Music

As musicians we will put together all the skills we have learnt over the year and put them into an end of year production. Here, we will showcase our singing and acting skills for our families and the rest of the school community.

RE

As theologians, we will explore the concept of peace explaining its meaning and understand its significance through submission for Muslims. We will explore what peace means to Muslims, identifying situations where peace may be challenged, and reflect on our own experiences of peace.

PE

As athletes we will develop our skill through improving our fitness with circuit training. Outside, we will be preparing for Sports Day by perfecting our athletic skills. We will continue to think about what makes a good sports person.

Learning Quest: History

- **Build it up:** Create a model of a Greek temple or landmark from Ancient Greece.
- **It's all Greek to me:** Create a poster explaining the language legacy of the Ancient Greeks.
- **Monster Model:** Create a model out of whatever you like depicting a Greek monster.

Learning Quest: English

- **Mythical Creature Fact File:** Create a fact file or report on a mythical creature as if it were real. Include a description, habitat, diet, powers, and sightings!
- **Mythical Quest Map & Story:** Design a map for a hero's journey through ancient lands. Label key locations, then write a short adventure story based on the map.

Learning Quest: Science

- **Nature Detective:** Find 5 different plants or animals. Draw or photograph them and group them by their features.
- **Linnaeus Timeline:** Make a timeline of Linnaeus's life and work on classification.
- **Microscope Drawing:** Look at pond water or soil under a microscope and draw what you see.

Learning Quest: Ideas for family time:

- **Animal Family Tree:** Choose an animal and make a family tree showing its relatives.
- **Virtual Visit:** Take a virtual tour of Ancient Greece at the [British Museum](#).
- **Olympics:** Hold a mini-Olympics with your family. Design events and prizes to be won.
