

Admission Appeals Timetable for Year R (*starting school in reception*) and Year 3 (*Infant to Junior school transfer*) in September 2020

For **community** and **voluntary controlled** schools (i.e. schools for which Hampshire County Council is the admission authority) appeals will follow the timetable below:

For infant, junior and all-through primary schools which are their own admission authority (i.e. Academy, Foundation, Trust and Voluntary Aided schools), please refer to the individual school for their appeal dates.

National notification date for on-time applicants	Thursday 16 April 2020
Notification date for late applicants (<i>whose applications received after 15 January and before 16 April 2020</i>)	Friday 24 April 2020
Deadline date for parents wishing to lodge an appeal (<i>returning completed appeal papers to the County Council</i>)	Monday 18 May 2020
Appeal hearings to be held	From 08 June to 17 July, inclusive
Decision letters to be sent	Within 5 school days of hearing

Please note

- (i) Appeals lodged after 18 May will be heard during the above dates if possible or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged. Appeals lodged on or after 12 June may not be heard until the autumn term but no more than 30 school days after the appeal was lodged.
- (ii) Appellants will receive at least 10 school days' notice of the exact date and location of their appeal hearing.
- (iii) Following the lodging of an appeal, additional papers may be submitted to the Appeals Service until 10 working days before the hearing. Evidence admitted after this date will be considered by the panel but this may lead to an adjournment and significant delays.
